The Saharawi of Algeria	There are hardly any followers of Jesus among the Saharawi and very few workers among this unreached Muslim people group of about one million. Because of a long-lasting war in the region, thousands and thousands of Saharawis fled to their homeland to Algeria. Around 180,000 Saharawis have been stranded there since 1991 in what has become one of the oldest refugee camps in the world. There is little food, medical care, or education. Every day is a struggle for survival. Pray for workers who are willing to work among the Saharawi and together with Him, carry the living water to the desert. Pray God will send dreams and visions among the Saharawi, showing Himself as the giver of living water and awakening their thirst for spiritual refreshment. Pray that the few local followers will grow in their faith and witness courageously
